# Webinar "Confined Space Entry"

Any manual work can be quite dangerous. Keeping workers and other people involved in such work environments informed is necessary, in every case.

At the same time we observe a lack of knowledge in the field of work that takes place in Closed Confined Spaces. For example, many workers do not know that a company needs a special permit to allow their workers to perform tasks in those spaces. This permit has to do with the protection of workers as well as the level of danger of confined space. This, of course, is just one of the many details that both workers and owners of companies should first know about before starting to work in such spaces.

The EFNMS – European Federation of National Maintenance Societies is organizing a webinar about "**Confined Space Entry**". It will take place on May 6th, 2019 (14:00–16:00 CET) and will be able to transfer knowledge to all interested participants, about the importance of maintaining a safe behavior while working in PRCS, what to do when they identify one and how they are supposed to proceed.

Some of the most important topics of this training will be the following:

- How to identify a confined space in the workplace with examples
- How to distinguish whether a confined space is a PRCS

- How to conduct a Risk Assessment by identifying the hazards
- Hazardous atmospheres (toxic, flammable, asphyxiating etc.)
- What does a Safe Method of Work in a PRCS include
- What type of measurements must be conducted prior to entry and in what order

The trainer, Dr. **George Scroubelos** is the Chairman of the EFNMS OH&S Committee, has a lot of experience working in industrial plants and underground mining operations.
