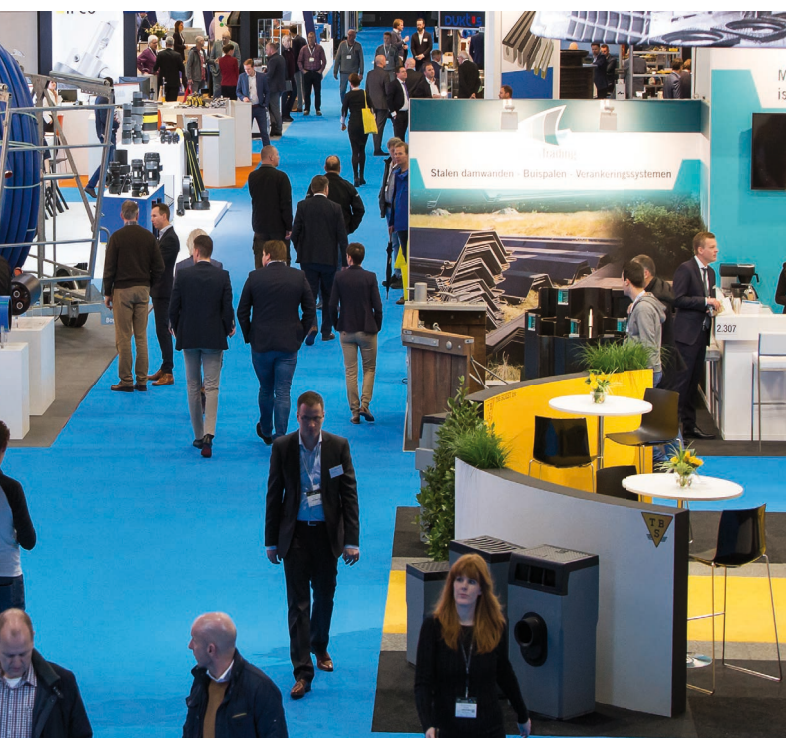
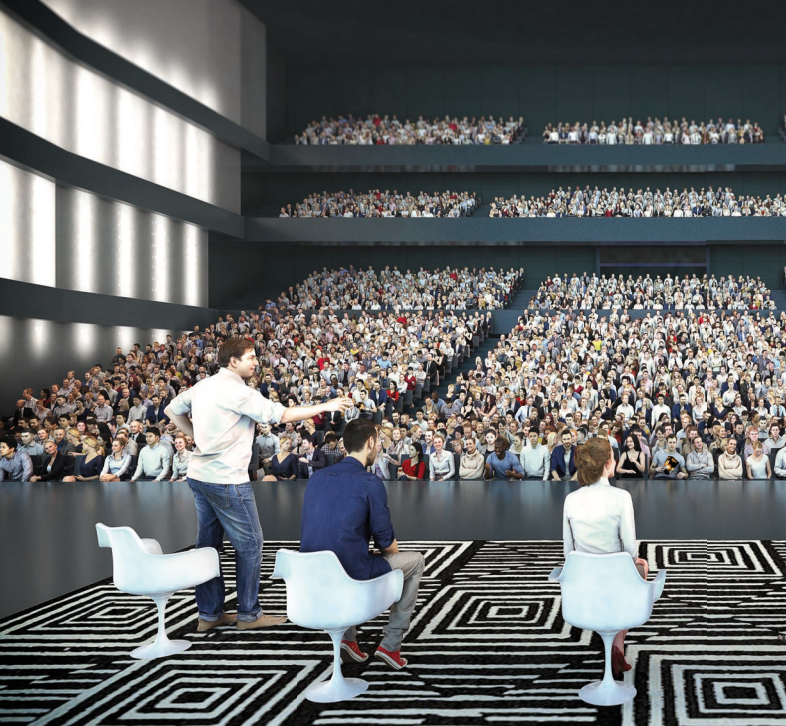

ALL SECTORS

The Dutch maintenance sector represents between 31 and 36 billion euros, around 4 to 5% of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP). The sector also employs around 310,000 maintenance professionals. That is equivalent to approximately 3.5% of the labour force. Together, **Maintenance NEXT** and **EuroMaintenance** represent the total maintenance sector. Whereas Maintenance NEXT mainly focuses on maintenance in the petrochemical and heavy process industry, EuroMaintenance oversees all sectors: Food, Beverage and Pharma; The built environment; Process industry; Infrastructure and Manufacturing.

During the **combined three-day event**, all current topics will be discussed, such as shortages in the technical labour market, operational excellence, innovation, compliance and sustainability. And on behalf of the scientific community, cooperation is sought with technical universities. In other words: *asset management at its best!*

INTERACTIVE

Every day, visitors will be able to choose from ten different workshops in which they actually get to participate, and every day EuroMaintenance guarantees ten presentations of a high international level. In addition, ten excursions will be organized each day to companies in and around Rotterdam. Asset management - and maintenance in particular - must be seen and not just heard about!
