










Networking Is Good



After the long period of COVID 19 restrictions the networking world is approaching the normal situation. We have seen several events and fairs being organized almost in normal circumstances all over Europe. The statistics from event organizers are showing that the number of visitors at fairs year 2022 have dropped some 30%-40% from "normal" figures. Organizers assume that the event industry will be back in traditional business figures in 5 years.

The big thing for EFNMS is coming Euromaintenance event in Rotterdam (Netherlands) which will take place 17-19th of April 2023 (https://www.euromaintenance.net/). It has been a long break after the Euromaintenance 2018 which was held in Antwerp Belgium. Euromaintenance 2023 in Rotterdam will again collect the top players in maintenance industry together – again with excellent

conference content and combined with Maintenance NEXT exhibition.

As we know there are some dark clouds on the sky concerning the situation in Europe - we all see the rising energy prices and uncertainty of international business. The interest for improving the energy efficiency is rising and professional maintenance is an effective part of the energy efficiency and circular economy. Most probably during the coming winter we will see and develop new innovative ways to save energy and get most out of the materials and tools we are using. To ensure and support this we must further improve the cooperation between the countries and business organizations.
